

Guidelines for Elections of National Executive Officers of AGI

These Guidelines, save as otherwise provided in the Regulations of AGI, shall govern elections of National Executive Officers of the Association of Ghana Industries.

1.0 Nominations

- 1.1 Nomination Forms for the various positions to be contested shall be completed and filed with the Chief Executive Officer at the National Directorate at least 21 days before the Annual General Meeting (AGM) in the case of National Executives.
- 1.2 Positions to be contested are as follows:

A. National Executives

- i. President
- ii. Vice President (LS)
- iii. Vice President (SMEs)
- iv. National Treasurer
- iv. 2 (Two) Elected Members

B. Eligibility

Only members in **good standing** at the time of Voting are eligible to Vote and Nominated as candidates for the election. For purposes of clarity, a member in **good standing** is interpreted as follows:

- i. A member who wishes to pay by Cheque for the purpose of Voting must do so two clear weeks and must be fully cleared before **Voting Day**.
- ii. A member who wishes to pay by Cash for the purpose of voting must do so one clear week before **Voting Day**.
- iii. A member **NOT** in good standing cannot be nominated for the elections at the time of filing.
- iv. A member **NOT** in good standing cannot propose or second a nomination at the time of filing.

2.0 Voting

- 2.1 Voting shall be as prescribed in the Regulations of AGI, except that:

In the case of Elected Executive Members at the National Elections, the first two candidates polling the highest votes will be declared elected.
